What does ACT stand for? **A: Acknowledge:** acknowledge when a friend or someone you know is struggling and has made some concerning statements. **C: Care:** show your loved one that you are concerned for them. **T: Tell:** tell a trusted adult or school mental health professional when the person has stated that he or she is experiencing suicidal thoughts. Though this may seem difficult, know you are doing the right thing to help your friend or loved one.

PLEASE FOLLOW NISD DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

When choosing what to wear to school please make sure you following the NISD Dress Code Guidelines in the Student Code of Conduct on the NISD website. No hats, caps, bandanas, or sweatbands may be worn in the school building. No sagging pants. As a general rule, shirt length needs to be below your waist...your garments shall not reveal your midriff or your back (no tank tops or racer-back style shirts). Please ensure under garments are not exposed/visible. Shorts, skirts, & dresses need to be mid-thigh or longer length. Pants may not have holes, be ragged, or torn above mid-thigh.
