BNHS STUDENT PARKING REQUIREMENTS

Attention All Students Who Drive to school: If you drive a vehicle onto campus, you are required to have a parking permit. Parking Permits are on sale for \$20 in the Counseling Center. Warning stickers are issued. If you receive a warning sticker you will be fined an additional \$10. Please purchase your parking permits immediately. Parking Permit Application forms can be found on the BNHS website and require a parent's signature. Thank you for keeping our campus safe. Please do not park in the reserved senior parking spots unless you are the senior student who purchased that exact reserved, senior parking space.

PLEASE FOLLOW NISD DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Students please wear your BNHS IDs at all times. When choosing clothing to wear to school please follow the NISD Dress Code Guidelines in the Student Code of Conduct on the NISD website. No hats, caps, bandanas, or sweatbands may be worn in the school building. No sagging pants. As a general rule, shirt length needs to be below your waist...your garments shall not reveal your midriff or your back (no tank tops or racer-back style shirts). Please ensure under garments are not exposed/visible. Shorts, skirts, & dresses need to be mid-thigh or longer length. Pants may not have holes, be ragged, or torn above mid-thigh.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING BLANKETS TO SCHOOL

Students, please do not bring blankets to school. It is against school practice; we consider them a health hazard. Students should instead be dressing in clothing layers for comfort.
