AP EXAM REGISTRATION

College Board Advanced Placement exam registration is open. Please see the BNHS website. Please note that if you are registering for an AP exam for a single semester course that you are enrolled in for fall of 2018, the deadline to register and pay for these AP exams, AND be exempt from the fall semester exam, is Monday, 12/10/18.
