Bobcat Swimming and Diving won against Keller Timber Creek and Central in a final tune up meet before the District Championship Meet. A new school record was set by Azalea Shepherd in the 200 IM as she took 1st along with another win in the 100 Fly. Other 1st place finishers include Kayci McKinnon 100 free, Kelli McKinnon 50 Free, and Taylor Felten, Elizabeth Bunger, Catie Richmond who combined for wins in all three relays. The boys team took first place with Thomas Bell in Diving and Sokol Bajraktari 100 Fly, Travis Kerbaugh 100 Back, Jarrod Carmody 200 IM, Ricky Taylor 500 Free who all combined with Nico Mauer, and Blayz Hood to take first in the 200 Medley and 400 Free Relays. The District Meet begins with diving on Friday, 1/18, at 5 PM with swimming finals starting on Saturday, 1/19, at 10 AM.
