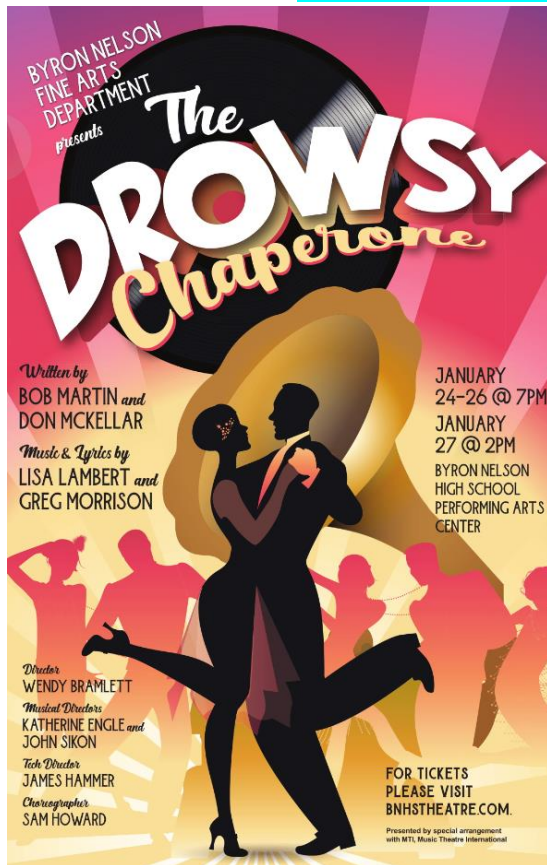

PAIGE FLICKINGER NAMED GATORADE TEXAS VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

BNHS student-athlete Paige Flickinger has been named the Gatorade 2018-19 Texas Volleyball Player of the Year, placing her among the top players in the nation. Shortly after the 2018 high school volleyball season concluded, the Texas Girls Coaches Association named Paige its 5A-6A Volleyball Player of the Year. With her Gatorade state selection, Paige is now in consideration for the Gatorade National Volleyball Player of the Year award. Both the state & national award recognizes athletic achievement as well as academic excellence & exemplary character. Flickinger is an 11th grade student this year who has verbally committed to play indoor & beach volleyball at Louisiana State University (LSU) after she graduates high school in 2020.

College Board Advanced Placement exam registration is open. **Total student cost per exam is \$68 if the student is registered/paid for each exam by 1/31/18.** Prices rise to \$78/exam beginning 2/1/18. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR CURRENT 11TH GRADE STUDENTS

The Coolidge; A Full-Ride Presidential Scholarship, covers tuition, room, board, & expenses for 4 years of undergraduate study at ANY accredited American university. Applicants must be current high school juniors (Class of 2020). Access the scholarship application at: www.coolidgescholars.org. Applications must be completed online & submitted by 4 PM on 1/23/19. The top 100 applicants are invited to participate in the Coolidge Senators Program which includes an all-expenses-paid Summit Weekend in Washington, D.C. & a one-time \$1,000 scholarship. Applicants who move forward to the finalist level each receive a one-time finalist scholarship award of \$5,000 (if they are not selected as one of the full 4-year scholarship award recipients).
