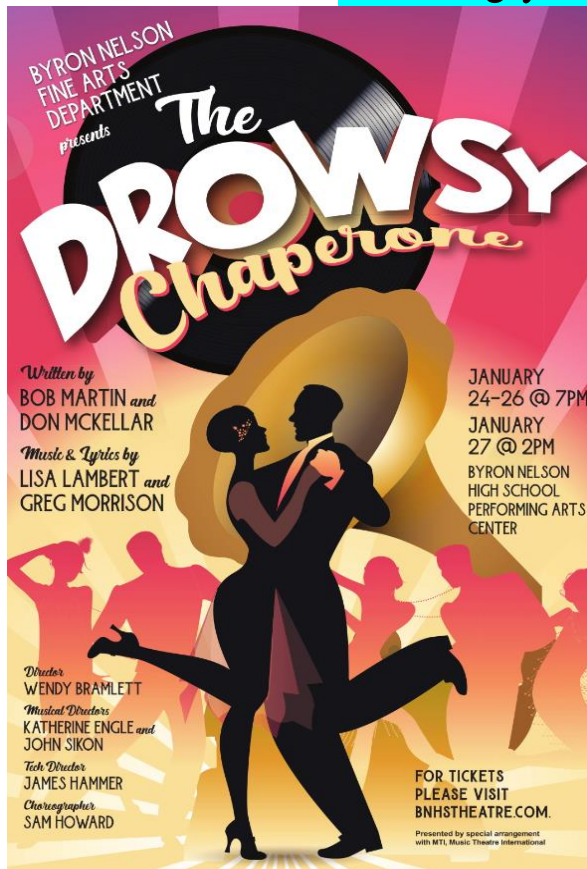

- 1) **Texas Student Housing 2019-2020 Scholarship applications** - Applicants should be interested in attending a college in Austin, College Station, or Denton, TX. Applications are due 01/31/19.
- 2) **EECU Scholarship applications** are available online for graduating seniors whose parent/legal guardian is a member of the credit union may apply.
