### **EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE IN LOCAL, STATE, & NATIONAL ELECTIONS**

Students, provided you have already turned 18 or will have your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday by May 4, 2019, you have the opportunity to register to vote and cast your ballot in the May 4, 2019 election. If you have not yet registered to vote, Voter Registration forms are available in both the BNHS Front Office & Counseling Office. Students and staff may complete the registration form in pen & seal it, then drop it in a U.S. mailbox or give it to Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office and she will mail it for you. Your registration form may be mailed in when you are within 2 months of your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday or once you are 18 years of age or older. The last day to register to vote for the May election is Thursday, 4/4. If you have questions, talk with Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office.
