***The Texas Dept. of Transportation offers a Conditional Grant Program** – Available to eligible students pursuing a degree in civil engineering or a department-approved operational business discipline. Students accepted into the program receive up to \$3,000/semester or \$6,000/academic year for tuition, based on financial need. Completed applications with supporting documents must be mailed to the Texas Department of Transportation in Austin, TX (specific address is provided on the application).

***Gerald Kendrick Memorial Scholarship applications** – (2) \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded. Applications are due 3/15/19 by emailed to: scholarship@CollinCountyTAAO.org or mailed to the Pounders Law Firm in Dallas prior to 3/15/19.

EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE IN LOCAL, STATE, & NATIONAL ELECTIONS

Students, provided you have already turned 18 or will have your 18th birthday by May 4, 2019, you have the opportunity to register to vote and cast your ballot in the May 4, 2019 election. If you have not yet registered to vote, Voter Registration forms are available in both the BNHS Front Office & Counseling Office. Students and staff may complete the registration form in pen & seal it, then drop it in a U.S. mailbox or give it to Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office and she will mail it for you. Your registration form may be mailed in when you are within 2 months of your 18th birthday or once you are 18 years of age or older. The last day to register to vote for the May election is Thursday, 4/4. If you have questions, talk with Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office. See flyer on next page.
