EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE IN LOCAL, STATE, & NATIONAL ELECTIONS

Students, if you are 18 or will have your 18th birthday by 5/4/19, you have the opportunity to register to vote & cast your ballot in the May 4, 2019 election. Voter Registration forms are available in both the BNHS Front Office & Counseling Office. Please complete the registration form in pen & seal it, then drop it in a U.S. mailbox (or give it to Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office & she will mail it for you). *Your voter registration form may be mailed any date within 2 months of your 18th birthday or any date after you've turned 18. The last day to register to vote for the May 2019 Election is this Thursday, 4/4. If you have questions, talk with Mrs. Huizenga in the BNHS front office.
