GIRLS' GOLF TEAM ADVANCES TO STATE

The Girls' Golf Team is headed to STATE as the result of finishing 3rd in the Region 1-6A Golf Championship. The Bobcats were led by sophomore MacKenzie Moore's 7th place finish shooting 73-74, placing her on the All Region Team. Freshman Estelle Seon shot 77-73, and senior captain Hunter Gillis turned in rounds of 74-77. Other team members included senior Kate Laird and sophomore Jillian Brown. The Bobcat girls are now one of the top 12 teams in the state 6A division that have earned the opportunity to compete at the State Championship tournament on May 13th and 14th in Georgetown. BOYS' GOLF TEAM ADVANCES TO STATE

The Boys' Golf Team punched their ticket to STATE after finishing 3rd in the toughest region in the state in class 6A shooting a pair of 294's. The Bobcats were led by Individual Regional Silver Medalist & Senior Captain David Harrison who broke another school record shooting 68-69, 7 under par for the tournament, qualifying him for All Region Honors. Fellow senior captain Joseph Jones had an outstanding tournament as well, shooting 1 over par 72-73 hitting 36 fairways in the tournament. Other team members included seniors Nathan Sudberry and Brady Larza along with junior Logan Johnson. The Bobcat boys are now one of the top 12 teams in state 6A. They will compete in the State Championship tournament on May 20th and 21st in Georgetown. WELL PLAYED BOYS!

Springer will be finishing off his collegiate golf career at the NCAA's next month, followed by an extensive amateur schedule this summer, before making his decision on turning professional in the fall. As a result of his win this past weekend, Springer received an exemption into next year's PGA Tournament at The Greenbrier in West Virginia!
